2015 was the warmest year Jean-François has ever seen in Bouzy, the perfect opportunity for his Coteaux Champenois debut. It evolved magnificently across three tastings spanning nine months, into an elegantly understated style of Chambolle-esque fragrance. Vibrant red cherry fruits, beetroot, pink pepper and musk morph into deeper allusions of blackberry, black cherry and fruit mince spice that showcase the presence and depth of Bouzy. Vibrant, focused Champagne acidity, firm, fine tannins and fine chalk minerality define a refreshingly lighter style with a very long future stretching out before it.
